The weekend includes workshops, worship, a question-and-answer session, a talk about current job openings, a tour of Cedar Ridge, and a panel discussion with current year-round staff. For just \$75.00, participants will receive two nights lodging, four meals, and airport shuttles on Friday evening and Sunday morning. LODGING AND TRANSPORTATION

[Cedar Ridge Camp and Retreat Center](#) is located on 64 acres in the last rural corner of Louisville, Kentucky. It is adjacent to the Parklands, a 3,000 acre park project - one of the largest new parks in the United States. The camp was started in 1957 and has many of the original buildings including a dining hall, two retreat lodges, and many rustic cottages. The camp is set on a small lake and offers high and low ropes, zip-line, swimming, horseback riding, archery, canoeing, and hiking trails. Linens will be provided to participants. If you have dietary restrictions, please let us know upon registration.

The nearest airport is Louisville International Airport (SDF), which is about 25 minutes away from camp. We will provide a shuttle from the airport by 6 PM, so plan to arrive by 5:30 PM on Friday. The program will begin Friday evening with some getting acquainted activities at 8 PM. We ask those driving to Cedar Ridge to arrive between 6pm and 7pm on Friday night. The program will end with breakfast and morning worship, so the shuttle back to the airport will leave around 10am on Sunday. Please schedule flights no earlier than 1:30pm.
